Dear Friends,

Have you ever noticed that “faith” can mean different things in different situations? If we put faith in an institution, it means that we think it will not fail us. If we have faith in someone we love, it means we know we can trust them. And when we talk about having faith in God or Christ, it often means agreeing to certain statements of belief.

But what if faith does not have to mean one thing in one situation, and mean something else in another? What if, instead, the kind of faith we are called to have in God or Christ is the same kind of faith we have in someone we love?

This Sunday we are continuing our Lenten series, “Secret Messages of Jesus,” by taking a look at Jesus’ sometimes surprising teaching on the subject of faith. Our Scripture reading will be Matthew 7:21-29, in which Jesus offers some ideas one faith that may be quite unexpected!

News from La Laguna

Campbell is in covenant relationship with Rainbow Network and with La Laguna, our partner community in rural Nicaragua. Because of our investment in the community and residents of La Laguna, lives have been positively impacted. For example, Justo Pastor is a young, humble man from La Laguna who recently graduated from high school in December. He has been connected with Rainbow Network since he was a baby and has thrived in his life due to the support he has received.

Justo’s mother, Rosa Argentina Murillo, is a mother of four, with Justo being her youngest. Justo had medical issues when he was young. Due to the family’s extremely limited resources and Justo’s questionable health at an early age, his mother did not think he would be able to attend school at all.

Thanks to his sponsors and his scholarship, Justo Pastor was able to attend all his classes, and he earned his diploma on December 5th. He is hoping to pass his entrance exams and begin studying at the university in Matagalpa to become a teacher. None of this would have been possible with the generosity of Campbell and other Rainbow Network supporters.
